

TRAVEL INFORMATION

The Secretary of Foreign Relations is the official Mexican authority in charge of international relations.

If you have additional questions not contained in this information, please direct them through the organizers.

Visas

All foreigners should bear a valid and unexpired passport or travel document with at least six months of validity.

If you wish to travel to Mexico as a tourist, in transit or for non-remunerated activities, for a period of less than 180 days, you **DO NOT NEED A VISA if you are a holder of:**

- *An unexpired visa (any class) from Canada, the United States of America, Japan, UK or any country pertaining the Schengen Space.*
- *A valid and unexpired card that shows permanent residence in Canada, the United States of America, Japan, UK or any other country pertaining the Schengen Space or any country member of the "Alianza del Pacífico".*

National Institute of Migration in México requirement

Multiple Migratory Form (FMM)

The applicant for the Multiple Immigration Form obtained electronically for air entry (FMME) must have a valid and current passport in accordance with international law regulations. In case the nationality requires it, you must present a valid and current Visa.

The applicant must enter the information required in the application for the Multiple Immigration Form obtained at the following link <https://www.inm.gob.mx/fmme/publico/solicitud.html> for air entry (FMME), as it appears on your passport.

Conditions of the Multiple Immigration Form obtained electronically

The Multiple Immigration Form for air entry can be obtained electronically through the Institute's web portal, foreigners who enter the country by air, through the places intended for international transit of people.

The applicant will print the Multiple Immigration Form obtained electronically for air entry (FMME) and must present it at the place destined for the international transit of people through which he intends to enter.

The applicant must present a valid and current passport and visa in case their nationality requires it, as well as the Multiple Immigration Form obtained electronically for air entry (FMME) at the time of requesting their admission.



Flights to Morelia

You can fly from Mexico City to Morelia (30 minute flight) or you can fly from several cities in the USA to Morelia as well.

In order for you to book your flights to and from Mexico City´s and Morelia´s airport please consider the following IATA Codes.

- Mexico City International Airport: IATA Code: MEX. (Aeropuerto Internacional Benito Juárez de la Ciudad de México - AICM)
- Morelia International Airport: IATA Code: MLM. (Aeropuerto Internacional General Francisco Mujica o Aeropuerto Internacional de Morelia)
